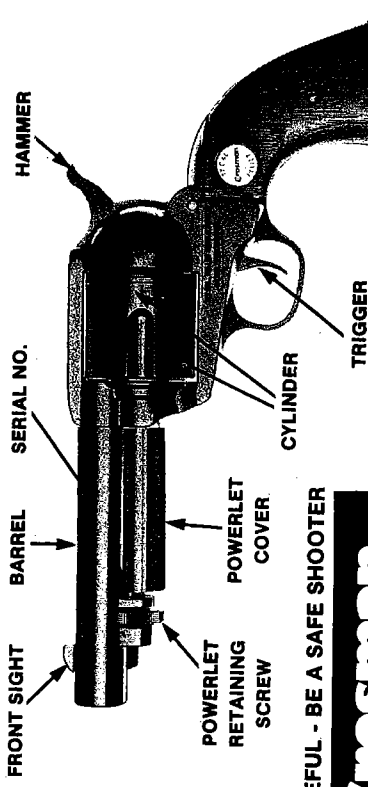

HOW TO OPERATE

IMPORTANT: Steps for safe and satisfactory operation.

- Step 1 Remove factory installed CO₂ Powerlet.
- Step 2 Load and pierce CO₂ Powerlet
- Step 3 Load Super Pellets
- Step 4 Aim and Fire

CAUTION: WEAR SAFETY GLASSES WHEN SHOOTING

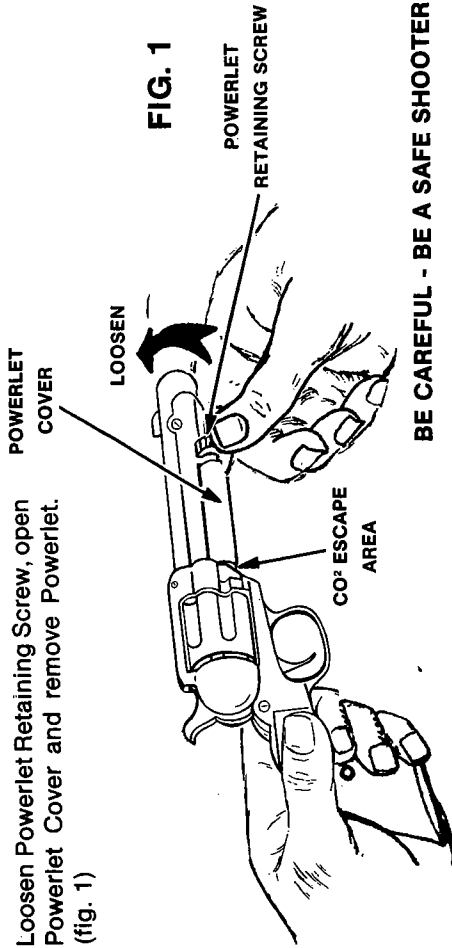
- Step 1 REMOVE THE FACTORY INSTALLED CO₂ POWERLET

Your new gun has an empty CO₂ Powerlet in it which must be removed. It was used to test the gun at the factory.

CAUTION: KEEP HANDS AWAY FROM ESCAPING CO₂. EXHAUSTED CO₂ GAS CAN CAUSE FROSTBITE WHEN ALLOWED TO COME IN CONTACT WITH SKIN.

Loosen Powerlet Retaining Screw, open Powerlet Cover and remove Powerlet. (fig. 1)

STEP 2 HOW TO LOAD AND PIERCE CO₂ POWERLET

CAUTION: BEFORE CHARGING WITH NEW POWERLET, ALL PELLETS MUST BE REMOVED FROM GUN. SEE PAGES 7-8 "How to remove pellets from the 44."

- A Place new Powerlet, small neck towards Trigger, into position.
- B. Turn Powerlet Retaining Screw (Fig. 2) until finger tight.

NOTE: To avoid damage to the gun never use pliers or any tool to tighten Powerlet Retaining Screw.

- C. Close Powerlet Cover.
- D. Cock and fire gun several times to pierce Powerlet. If gun fails to fire the Powerlet was not pierced. Remove and inspect Powerlet for small hole in nose. If Powerlet is not pierced, replace and repeat Step B.

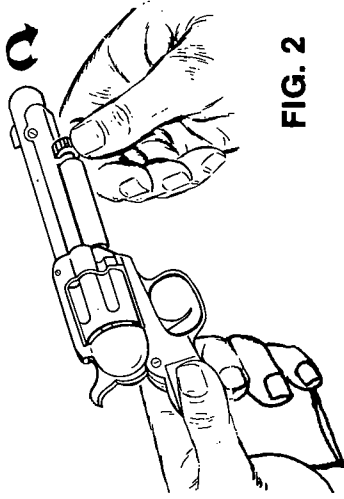

IMPORTANT: UNLOAD GUN. Cock Hammer and pull Trigger to pierce Powerlet. Don't try to pierce Powerlet by overtightening Powerlet Retaining Screw, or you will damage gun.
