RULES and STANDARDS

The Crosman National Series (CNS) is intended to promote interest in airguns through field target competition. By partnering with the American Airgun Field Target Association (AAFTA), Crosman will support local clubs by raising interest in their matches and promote the sport on a national level.

Eligibility

Competitors

- a. Only scores from participation in AAFTA-sanctioned matches conducted by an AAFTA Member Club may be counted in the CNS.
- b. Scores submitted by the AAFTA Member Club are considered official.
- c. Competitors must list the brand name (Crosman or Benjamin) and the model (Marauder, 1720T, Challenger, etc.) on the equipment list. Custom or hybrid products should include “custom” or “hybrid” after the model (Ex: Benjamin Marauder Custom; Crosman Challenger Hybrid)
- d. By participating in the CNS, competitors grant the use of their name and image to Crosman Corporation for use in press releases, promotions and advertising.

Equipment

The CNS is open to all participants of AAFTA-sanctioned matches that meet these equipment requirements:

- e. Rifle or pistol must be a Crosman or Benjamin product.
- f. Rifle or pistol may be current production or discontinued model.
- g. Rifle or pistol may be stock or modified but must be listed per its brand name and include the name of base model (ex: Benjamin Marauder Hybrid).
- h. Custom or hybrid products must be 51% original equipment to be eligible. Percentage is based on the number of parts.

Matches

- i. Matches must be sanctioned by AAFTA.
- j. The start of the competition season is defined as the first weekend following completion of the AAFTA U.S. National Championship. The season ends with the AAFTA U.S. National Championship. Matches that take place during this period will be included that season's CNS.
- k. AAFTA will communicate to Crosman all match reports submitted, either by email or link to a web page containing the report. By this communication, it is understood the match is recognized and approved by AAFTA and qualifying scores may be including in the CNS.
- l. Match reports not containing equipment details will not be included.

RIFLE

- m. Rifle matches must have a minimum Troyer Difficulty Rating of 25T, without taking into account environmental conditions (visibility or wind).
- n. Rifle matches must have a minimum of 50 shots.

PISTOL

- o. Pistol matches must have a minimum Target Difficulty Rating of 27T, without taking into account environmental conditions (visibility or wind).
- p. Pistol matches must have a minimum of 30 shots.

Member Clubs

- q. Only AAFTA Member Clubs in good standing may have their match participant scores counted in the CNS.
- r. Clubs that conduct eligible Matches that complete before the end of the season but do not submit their results before season's end will not have those scores count towards that year's CNS.

Scoring

- s. Scoring will be normalized based on the highest score for the match.
- t. CNS standings will be maintained for Rifle and Pistol with winners recognized for each.
- u. Scoring will be based on cumulative scores for the year with the highest point total being named the winner.
- v. Bonus points will be awarded for participants in regional and national matches:
 - a. Grand Prix regional match: 100 bonus points
 - b. Crosman All-American Championship: 200 bonus points
 - c. AAFTA National Championship: 200 bonus points
- w. Scoring will be maintained by Crosman Corporation.

Awards

- x. AAFTA will recognize the Rifle and Pistol CNS winner at the conclusion of the AAFTA U.S. National Championship.
- y. AAFTA will deliver photo(s) of the award presentation to Crosman if no Crosman representative is available to attend the event.
- z. Winners will be rewarded accordingly with recognition for the top three finishes in each of Rifle and Pistol:
 - a. First Place: \$400 gift certificate for crosman.com, free entry to the following year's Crosman All-American Field Target Championship.
 - b. Second Place: \$250 gift certificate for crosman.com, free entry to the following year's Crosman All-American Field Target Championship.
 - c. Third Place: \$100 gift certificate for crosman.com, free entry to the following year's Crosman All-American Field Target Championship.
- aa. Additional prizes may be awarded at Crosman's discretion.
