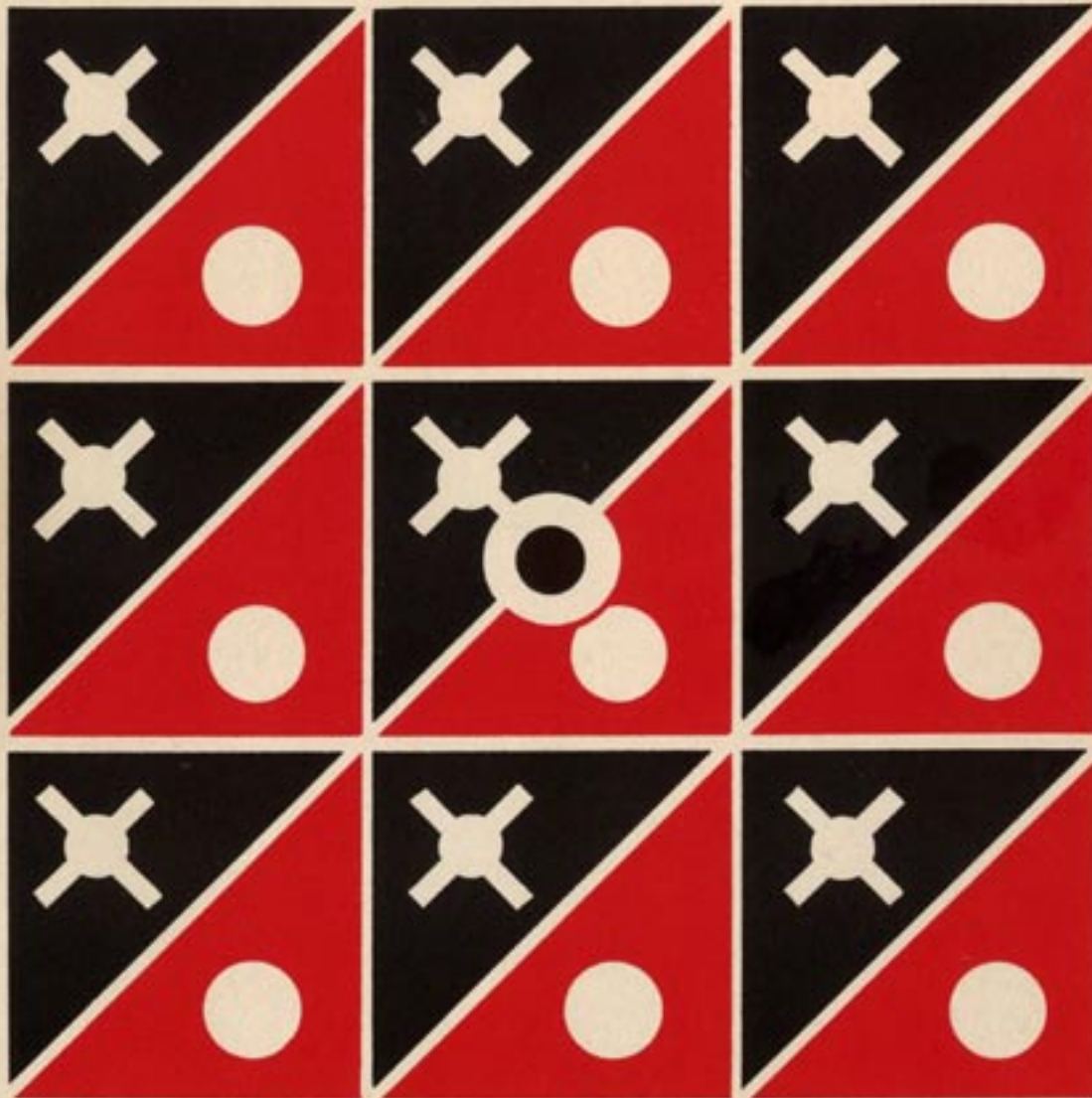

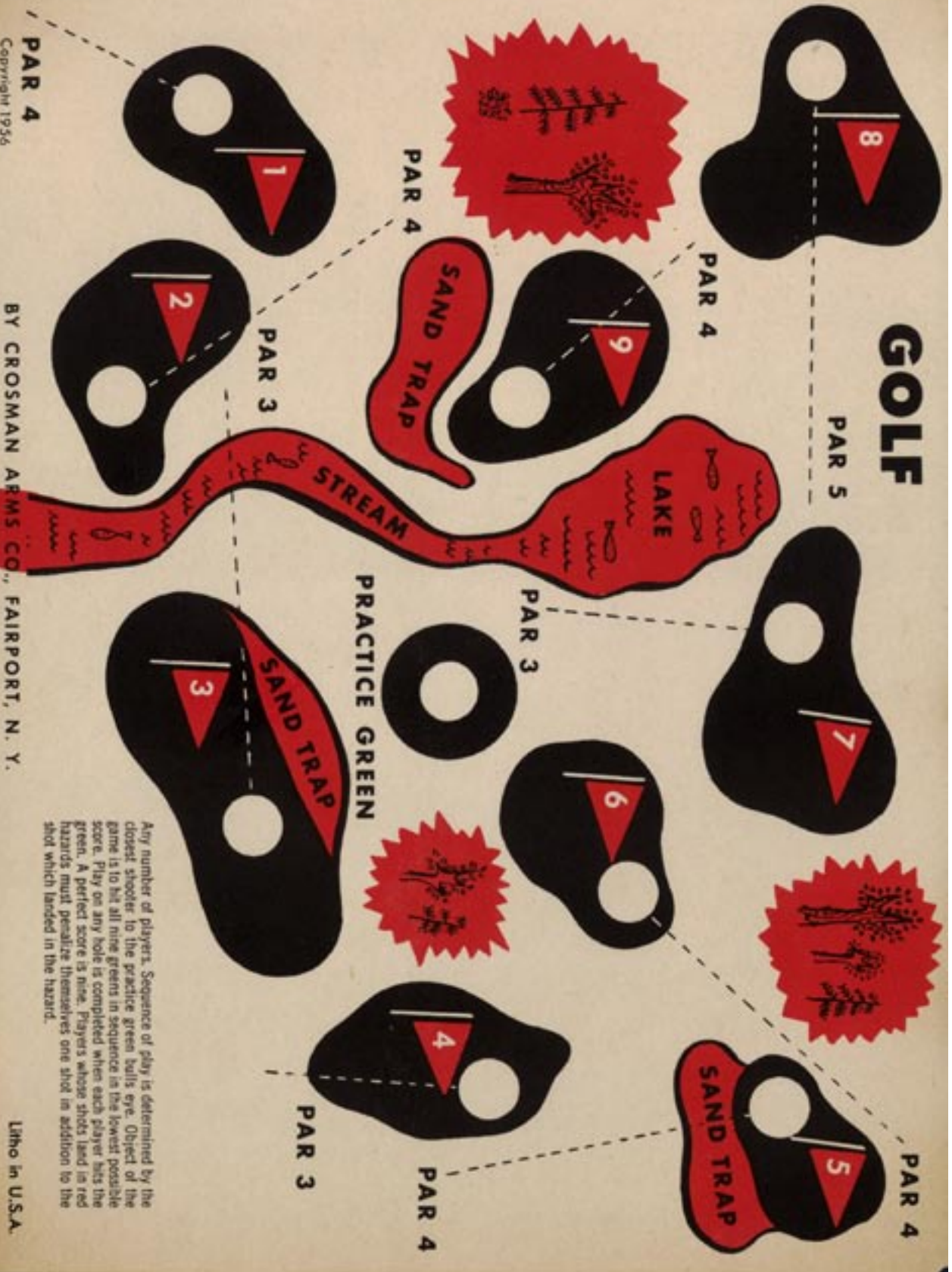

TIC-TAC-TOE



2 players or teams are needed. Closest player to center bulls eye on 1st shot starts game by selecting either X or O. Object of the game is to line up three X's or three O's across, up or down, or on a diagonal. Shots landing in either the X or O panel count. A shot in the opponents panel counts for him. One shot counts as a turn.

GOLF



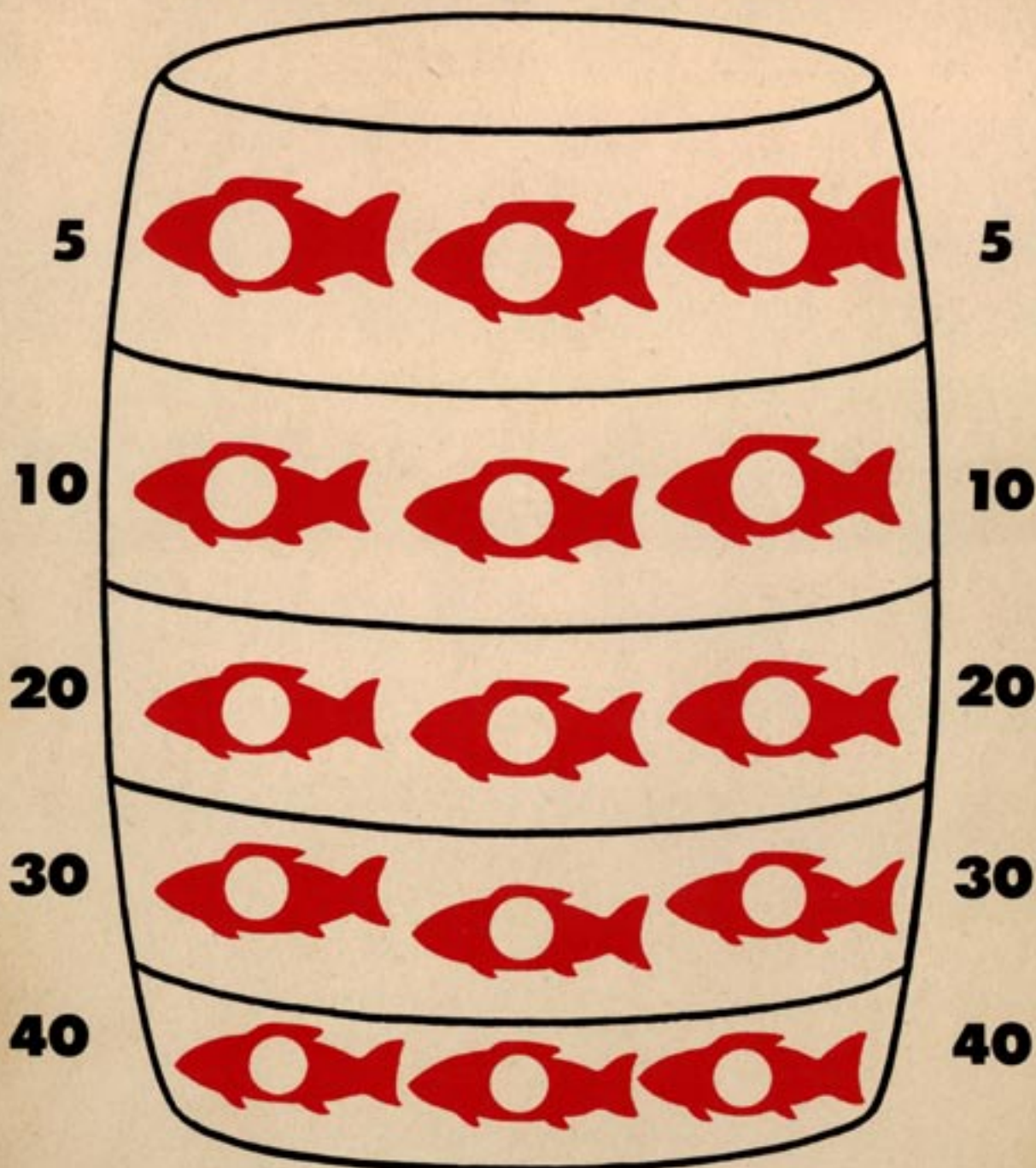
Any number of players. Sequence of play is determined by the closest shooter to the practice green ball's eye. Object of the game is to hit all nine greens in sequence in the lowest possible score. Play on any hole is completed when each player hits the green. A perfect score is nine. Players whose shots land in red hazards must penalize themselves one shot in addition to the shot which landed in the hazard.

FISH IN A BARREL



Any number of players or teams. Object of game is to hit the fish in the barrel in sequence (go down into the barrel and come out). Each team keeps shooting until one member misses the next higher value fish. A game is completed when one team scores 210 points.* I.E. a player or team who has hit say 3 fish in succession before missing has used only 1 turn.

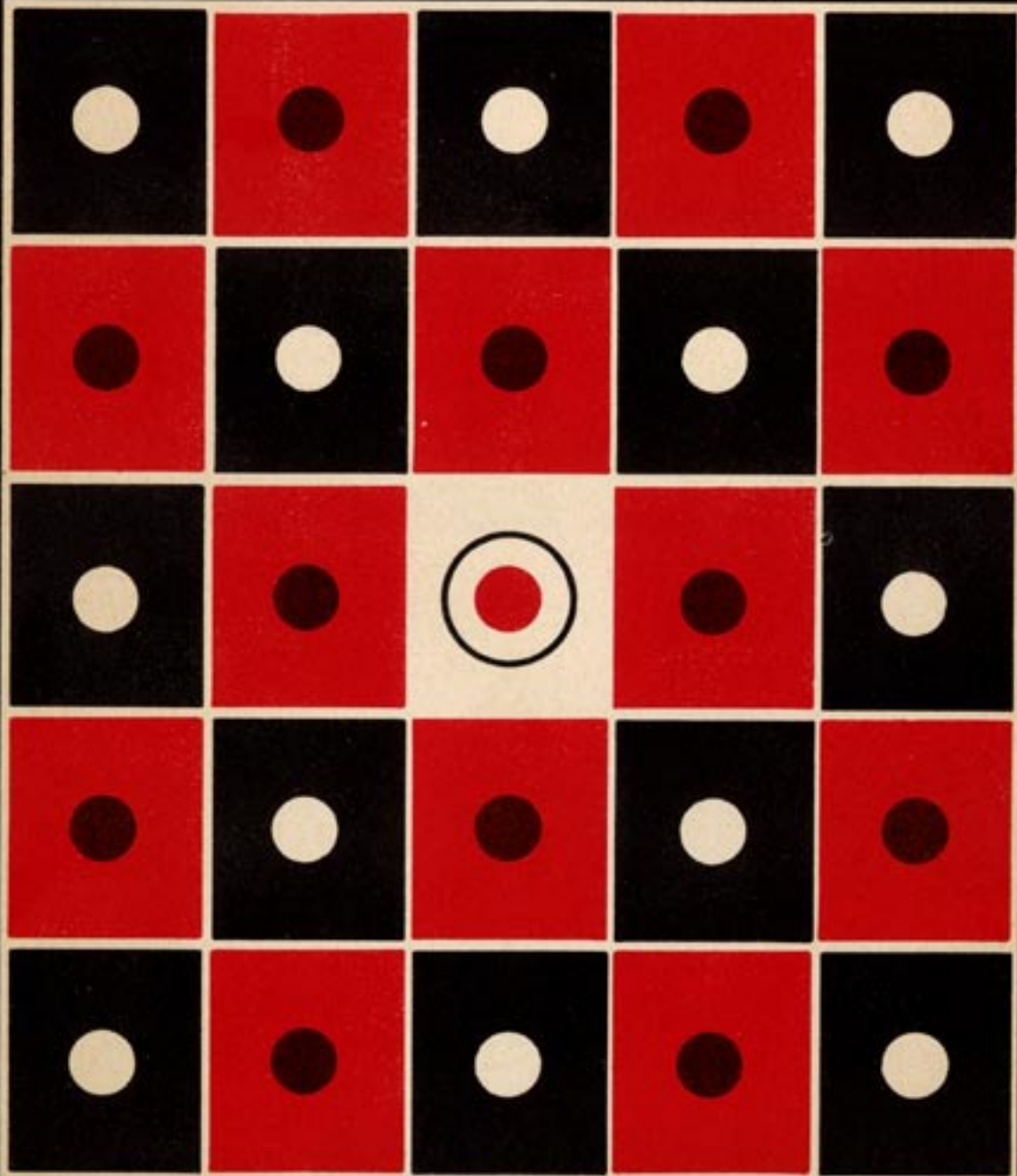
*In the event of a tie each team continues to shoot, one shot per member until one player misses. The other team is the winner.

Litho in U.S.A.

CHECKERS



2 players or 2 teams are needed. To determine first shooter one man from each team fires at center bulls eye. Closest shooter then selects his color red or black and play begins. Object is to hit all red or all

black squares. Winner is determined by team which scores one shot in each of all of the red or black squares. A shot in the opponents panel counts for him. One shot counts as a turn.

Litho in U.S.A.

ANAGRAMS

Any number of players or teams. Object is to hit panels or letters to spell a word. Limit on game is predetermined by length of word to be spelled. A game can be completed for a 5-6-7-8 or greater number of letters in a word. I.E. in a 6 letter word game the letters Z Y L I L A were hit in that order, they spell LAZILY. 1st team to get a six letter word found in any dictionary wins; regardless of the number of shots.
